Semester Report Form for Pianists

Each Artist Diploma pianist is expected to organize and present at least one public performance in a VAM-sponsored event each semester which involves working with at least one other person. A wide range of ensembles is possible to earn this credit, for example, playing in someone else's recital, performing the work of a VAM student composer, playing in a group at a college student recital, being part of the orchestra for an Orpheum concert, working with a singer for an external visitor Master Class, accompanying a string player for masterclass, or playing in a chamber music group. Preparation can include visiting other people's lessons, rehearsals, coaching, and so on. If you have a question or a proposal requiring extra coaching, please send it to the College Office for administration.

To claim this credit, fill out the semester report form and submit it to the College Office before the end of the semester along with a program, where possible.
